ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in a complaint case bearing No.26 dated 10.04.2014 (Annexure P-1) filed at the instance of respondent No.1.

Learned counsel states that the petitioner was not named in the complaint and was not summoned, but later on the revisional Court on the basis of statement made by the complainant has summoned the petitioner and the petitioner was arrested. He further urges that no notice of the revision was given to the petitioner and the main accused Chanan Singh had been allowed anticipatory bail and he had appeared before the trial Court.

No specific role was given to the petitioner in the complaint. The revisional Court without giving notice of hearing to the petitioner had allowed the revision and the petitioner has been arrested in a complaint case.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the Court below.
