DAYA CHAUDHARY, J. (ORAL)

This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for lodging of FIR against respondents No.4 to 6 as the petitioner has been cheated and defrauded by some other lady impersonating herself as Pritam Kaur and got the sale deed registered on 11.08.2010 who had already died on 13.10.1990.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has made a complaint (Annexure P-3) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural, which was marked to Economic Wing on 30.04.2015, which is clear from Annexure P-4. Subsequently also, a complaint was made which was again referred to Economic Wing on 10.08.2015 (Annexure P-5) but no action has been taken thereupon so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner

would be satisfied, in case, the directions are issued to respondent No.2 to take action on the complaint (Annexure P-3).

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and keeping in view the limited prayer of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider the complaint (Annexure P-3) moved by the petitioner and take necessary action thereupon in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
