Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.06 dated 05.01.2016 under Sections 452/323/324/326/148/149 of IPC, registered at Police Station C-Division Amritsar, District Amritsar.

This Court vide order dated 08.08.2016, has granted ad-interim bail to petitioner No.2 subject to joining the investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Agency/Investigating Officer and to abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to order dated 08.08.2016, petitioner No.2 has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Ashwani Kumar has stated that in terms of above order, petitioner No.2 has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 08.08.2016 qua petitioner No.2 are made absolute.

However, the petitioner No.2 shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
