Prayer is under Section 439 Cr.PC for grant of regular bail to the petitioner Jagroop Singh @ Butta Singh in case FIR No.50 dated 20.05.2014 for offences punishable under Sections 22/61/85 of the NDPS Act registered with Police Station Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

There is recovery of 1000 tablets of Microlit containing Diphenoxylate Hydrochloride which as per the FSL report dated 09.12.2014 is commercial in nature.

On the previous two dates also none was present on behalf of the petitioner. Same is the position today.

Learned State Counsel assisted by HC Gursewak Singh submits that petitioner is involved in two other case under the NDPS Act out of

which in one case he has been convicted. He further submits that only six witnesses remained to be examined and the trial is now fixed for 03.02.2016.

In view of the above, no case for grant of regular bail to the petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.
