INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No110 dated 09.03.2016, registered at Police Station Samalkha, under Section 379-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case.

Mr. Vikramjit Singh, Addl. A. G. Haryana has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, three boys snatched tractor-trolley, loaded with sand, from the complainant and took away. Those boys came on car and got the tractor stopped. It is also the case of prosecution that the complainant was also assaulted with sticks.

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Challan has already been presented and charges have already been framed against the accused including the present petitioner. No prosecution witness has been examined so far. At this stage, if the petitioner is released on bail, he may tamper with the evidence.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and seeing the gravity of offence, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled for the benefit of regular bail at this stage.
