This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.121 dated 15.09.2014 registered under Section 15/61/85 of NDPS Act, at Police Station Lehra, District Sangrur.

The case against the petitioner is that 60 kilograms of poppy husk was recovered from him and his co-accused.

Learned DAG, on instructions from ASI Purshotam Ram, states that only three witnesses remain to be examined by the prosecution and it would be appropriate to put a time cap on the trial so that the case can be decided finally. On instructions from the investigating officer he states that the prosecution will lead its entire evidence within a period of one month(subject to the accused not obstructing the same).

I find this to be a very fair statement.

Resultantly it is directed that in case the prosecution does not conclude its entire evidence by 31.08.2016 (subject to the accused not obstructing the same), the trial Court shall release the petitioner on bail to its satisfaction.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the Civil Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
