JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure preferred by Gopal, seeking regular bail, in case FIR No.171 dated 15.02.2016, under Section 379-B IPC, registered at Police Station Chandni Bagh Panipat, District Panipat.

It is an undisputed fact that the petitioner was arrested in this case on 27th March, 2016. He was subjected to custodial interrogation during which, a sum of Rs.5,000/- is stated to have been recovered from him. After the completion of investigation, challan has already been presented and now trial is listed for the evidence of the prosecution. In the given circumstances, further interrogation of the petitioner is not required. Moreover, the conclusion of the trial would sufficiently take time and this Court is of the considered view that it would not be desirable to keep the petitioner behind the bars for an indefinite period.

Taking into consideration all these aspects of the case but without expressing any opinion on merits, petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds as per the satisfaction of concerned Id. trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
