The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.30,
dated 23.6.2016, registered under Section 61-1-14 of the Excise Act, at
Police Station Qila Lal Singh Batala.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the alleged
recovery is of 200 kgs of illicit liquor and that the petitioner has now
been in custody since 23.6.2016.

Learned DAG Punjab, on instructions from ASI Manjinder

Singh, accepts this factual assertion but states that there are four other cases of similar nature pending against the petitioner and he is on bail in all those cases.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of.
