The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR
No.109, dated 5.9.2014, registered under Sections 21/61/85 of the NDPS
Act, at Police Station Phagwara City, Kapurthala.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the alleged
recovery of 80 grams of intoxicant powder is a non-commercial quantity
and the petitioner has now been in custody for the last one year and that

no other case is pending against him.

Learned DAG Punjab has accepted these factual assertions.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of.
