The petitioner along with the co-accused Harjinder Singh was allegedly found in possession of total 600 grams of Intoxicating Powder, 300 grams recovered from the petitioner and 300 grams from the dicky of the Activa, driven by Harjinder Singh. The petitioner has been in custody with effect from 09.04.2016.

On the instructions of Head Constable Tejinder Singh, learned State counsel informs that the report of the Chemical Examiner has not yet been received.

This petition is disposed of with a direction that petitioner will be released on interim temporary bail, till the receipt of the report of the Chemical Examiner, on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Area Magistrate. It is further directed that on receipt

of the report of Chemical Examiner, the petitioner would be required to surrender before the Court of competent jurisdiction and seek concession of regular bail again which is expected to be decided on the basis of its merits thereafter.

Disposed of with above said directions.
