Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Petitioner is a woman and the offence is said to be the first offence. Learned State counsel states that no other offence is registered against her. There was recovery of 40 grams of Heroin and ₹2.50 lacs from the Car and the petitioner ran away from the spot.

Be that as it may, the quantity being non-commercial and petitioner being a woman and since the petitioner is ready to furnish undertaking not to commit similar or any kind of offence in future, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. In the event of arrest, petitioner shall be released on anticipatory bail in FIR in question, on her furnishing bail bonds amounting to ₹10,000/- with one surety of like amount, subject to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer. Petitioner shall furnish undertaking not to commit similar or any kind of offence in future.

Petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
