Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct fair investigation in case FIR No.73 dated 29.7.2015 under Sections 3 and 4 of the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 as well as Section 506 IPC registered at Police Station Verowal, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though the FIR was registered on 29.7.2015, but till date, the police has not completed the investigation. He further submits that for the relief claimed in the present petition, the petitioner has also made a representation dated 29.4.2016 (Annexure P-2) to respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police,

Tarn Taran, but no action thereon has been taken by the police so far.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to take note of the contents of representation (Annexure P-2) and to act in accordance with law.
