Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Hari Ram in Complaint Case No.933 of 30.11.2012 titled as “Nihal Singh Vs. Hari Ram & Ors.” for offences punishable under Sections 323, 324, 326, 341 and 34 of Indian Penal Code pending in the Court of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Narnaul wherein he has been summoned vide order dated 30.05.2015.

It is contended that out of the occurrence on 10.11.2012 between the collateral's the petitioner side has lodged an FIR No.303 dated 18.11.2012 for offences punishable under Sections 323, 324, 452, 506 and

34 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Narnaul, District Mahendergarh and all the accused named therein have been granted bail.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the directions passed by this Court, the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and has been granted interim bail. He further submits that he is ready and willing to face trial.

In view of the above, interim bail granted by the trial Court is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
