Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Nachhattar Singh, submits that the petitioner has since joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute, though on behalf of complainant Mr. Singla has sought to oppose the same.

In the light of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated -23.7.2016 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
