Petitioner has been in custody with effect from 31.03.2015 in a case registered at the instance of Amarjit Singh alleging that the petitioner was employed in the Security Branch, Moga and in connivance with other accused, he got forged and fabricated papers to send his relatives abroad. He is also involved in the scam of preparing forged passports of the criminals in the name of dead persons.

Petitioner in connivance with his wife has allegedly got his children admitted in the school by giving wrong details and by changing the name of their parents and earned huge money by committing such frauds.

Learned counsel for the complainant has intervened to oppose the bail application contending that the petitioner is a habitual offender and that the petitioner has even got registered an FIR No.

204 dated 25.07.2009 against the complainant.

On the instructions of Head Constable Shivender Singh, learned State counsel informs that the challan has already been presented. No wrongful loss appears to have been caused to the complainant by any act of the petitioner. Petitioner in said circumstances can be granted the concession of bail.

The petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
