The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.65 dated 22.06.2016 registered at Police Station Bahaw Wala, Distt. Fazilka under Sections 498-A, 406, 323, 506 IPC.

The parties were sent to Mediation, but it had failed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and a draft of Rs.44,000/- was given before the trial Court on 30.08.2016. This fact is not disputed by the complainant but it was stated that recovery has not been effected.

In view of above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated

27.07.2015 is hereby made absolute subject to the condition contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. The complainant shall be at liberty to raise the issues of recovery before the trial Court at an appropriate stage.
