Petitioners filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.60 dated 22.05.2016, registered at Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar, under Sections 307, 452, 506, 148 and 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act.

Vide order dated 23.07.2016, petition qua petitioner No.1-Beant Singh has been dismissed and notice of motion has been issued only qua petitioner No.2-Harpal Singh alias Bhalla.

Ms. Shivali, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for petitioner No.2 as well as

learned State counsel and gone through the record.

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From the record, I find that no injury has been attributed to petitioner No.2. In pursuance of the interim order dated 23.07.2016 passed by this Court, petitioner No.2 has already joined the investigation. He is now not required for custodial interrogation. Nothing is to be recovered from him.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and no useful purpose will be served by sending petitioner No.2 to custody, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed qua petitioner No.2 accordingly. The order dated 23.07.2016, granting interim bail to petitioner No.2, is made absolute. However, petitioner No.2 shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
