Challenged in the present petition is the summoning order dated 27.4.2013 ((Annexure P2), passed by the learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Jagraon in a Criminal Case No.224/1 of 16.7.2009 titled as *Bishamber Dass v. Gurdeep Singh and others*.

The petitioner also seeks quashing of the criminal complaint.

I am of the view that the impugned order is revisable. Therefore, the petitioner is relegated to avail the remedy of revision before the Sessions Court at first instance. Keeping in view the fact that the present petition remained pending before this Court, it is further directed that if the revision is filed within 30 days from today, the Sessions Court shall decide the same on merits notwithstanding the delay in filing the same.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
