This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to transfer the investigation in case FIR No.114 dated 15.03.2016 under Sections 304-B, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Hansi Sadar (District Hisar) Annexure P-1 to some Senior Police Officer of another district or to some independent investigating agency.

On issuing notice of motion in this case, reply has been filed by learned State counsel by way of affidavit of DSP, Hansi, District Hisar, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 and 7, stating that after registration of the FIR, the investigation was carried out by ASI Karambir and accused Jagbir was arrested on 25.03.2016 and remaining three accused persons were arrested on 26.03.2016 and they were produced before the Court at Hansi. The investigating officers recorded the statement of witnesses under Section 161 Cr.P.C. and prepared rough site plan. After completion of investigation, challan was present before the Illaqa Magistrate, Hansi on 14.06.2016 and

charges under Sections 304-B, 34 IPC and in the alternate Section 302 IPC were framed against the accused persons on 22.07.2016 and the case was fixed for prosecution evidence and for awaiting chemical examination report on 09.09.2016. Now the case is fixed for prosecution evidence on 03.10.2016.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the matter and the present petition is disposed of accordingly.
