This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.114 dated 26.06.2015 registered under Section 377 IPC and Section 4 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 at Police Station Sadar, Khanna, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been in custody since June, 2015.

Learned Additional Advocate General on instructions from H.C. Charanjit Singh states that only 9 witness remain to be examined and in case the petitioner does not obstruct the trial the prosecution will lead its entire evidence on or before 30.11.2016 and till such time the bail should not be granted to the petitioner.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, in view of the undertaking given by the learned Additional Advocate General, it is directed that in case the prosecution does not lead its entire evidence on or before 30.11.2016 (subject to the petitioner not obstructing the same) the petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
