The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.849 dated 06.12.2014 registered under Sections 395, 397 IPC and 25/54/59 of Arms Act at Police Station City Hansi, District Hissar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 15.12.2014 and the complainant has turned hostile inasmuch as he has refused to recognize the petitioner.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Hanuman Singh has accepted this factual assertion. He further submits that one pistol and four cartridges have been recovered from the petitioner.

Be that as it may, keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner and without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny him the concession of bail.

Bail to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Hissar.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
