The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.136 dated 20.06.2016, registered under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station City Ferozepur.

Heard.

On 29.09.2016, the following order was passed:-

“The learned counsel for the complainant states that he does not oppose the present petition subject to fulfillment of the undertaking made on 20.09.2016 before this Court.

Post again on 09.11.2016

The amount of Rs.1,50,000/- be paid in the meantime, out of which 50% of the amount shall be paid within 10 days from today. Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting Officer, she shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

1.That she shall make herself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;

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authenticity of this document
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2.That she shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;
3.That she shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in pursuance of order dated 29.09.2016, the amount of Rs.1.50 lacs has been paid to the complainant.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 29.09.2016, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
