INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., seeking regular bail in case FIR No.44 dated 13.03.2016, registered at Police Station Sadar Ambala, Ambala Cantt., District Ambala, under Section 15 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Vikramjit Singh, Addl. A.G., Haryana, has accepted notice on behalf of respondent-State and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, this Court finds that 2 kg. 500 grams poppy husk has been recovered from the petitioner which falls in non-commercial quantity. The petitioner is in custody since 13.03.2016. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without

expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition stands accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.30,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
