Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.148 dated 07.06.2016, registered at Police Station Ladwa, District Kurukshetra, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 452, 506 IPC.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Vikramjit Singh, Addl. A.G., Haryana, has accepted notice on behalf of respondent(s)-State and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

The petitioner is in custody since 08.06.2016. He is no more required for investigation or interrogation purposes. The offences are triable by the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without

expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition stands accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.30,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
