DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 72 dated 3.9.2013 registered under Section 306 IPC at Police Station Sadar Banga, District S.B.S. Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has falsely been implicated, whereas, no offence is made out. Co-accused of the petitioner, namely, Balbir Chand has approached this Court by way of filing Crl. Misc. No. M-253 of 2015 to challenge summoning order, wherein, notice of motion has been issued on 28.1.2015 and operation of impugned order has been stayed.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State on instructions from

ASI Satnam Singh submits that all the witnesses have been examined and the petitioner is not entitled to regular bail at this stage.

On perusal of order passed in the case of co-accused-Balbir Chand, it is clear that only the operation of summoning order has been stayed and the proceedings before the trial court were not stayed.

Keeping in view the stage of the trial, no ground is made out to grant regular bail to the petitioner and the present petition being devoid of any merit is hereby dismissed.

However, the trial Court is directed to proceed with the trial.
