Petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No. 20 dated 17.02.2014 under Sections 324, 341, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Dehlon on the complaint of Gurdeep Singh alleging that on 15.02.2014, the complainant was attacked by the petitioners armed with 'Khirsch' and stick etc.

Parties are stated to have compromised the matter.

Parties were directed to appear before the trial Court and get their statements recorded. After recording the statements of the parties, the report has been received to the effect that the matter has been compromised without any threat, coercion or undue influence. The chances of achieving conviction by the prosecution, in such circumstances, is absolutely remote.

In view of the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh vs. State of Punjab, 2007 (3) Recent Criminal Reports (P&H), 1052**, I am of the opinion that on account of the matter

having been amicably resolved between the parties, neither any useful purpose will be served nor any fruitful result by trial would be achieved.

The petition is allowed. The aforesaid and all the consequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise subject to a condition that petitioners will deposit a total sum of Rs. 10,000/- with the Member Secretary, Punjab State Legal Services Authority, Chandigarh within a period of one month.
