Learned State counsel submits that trial is near its culmination and the case is at the stage of recording statement under Section 313 of the Criminal Procedure Code. Keeping in view the fact that the trial is at its fag end and day to day proceedings are being held, no ground is made out for enlarging the petitioner on bail.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to file afresh, in case trial does not conclude within a period of two months, which shall be subject to condition that petitioner would not delay the trial in any manner.
