By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have sought anticipatory bail in a complaint case bearing No.11 dated 30.01.2015, registered under Sections 302 and 120-B of IPC, at Police Station Sadar Jalalabad.

On 25.07.2016, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Petitioners have been summoned as accused in a private complaint under Section 302 IPC.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners along with Balbir Singh and others were accused of the same offence but on investigation they were found innocent and challan was presented only against Balbir Singh.

Notice to the respondent for November 8, 2016.

Meanwhile, an interim direction is issued that the petitioners will put in appearance before the summoning Court on next date of hearing and in case of their so, they will be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the said Court.”

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of order dated 25.07.2016, the petitioners have appeared before the trial Court and have furnished bail/surety bonds. The certified copy of order dated 29..07.2016, passed by the trial Court is taken on record as Mark 'A'.

The learned counsel for the respondent does not dispute the above said fact.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 25.07.2016, is made absolute.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
