Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos. 4 to 8.

It is stated that the petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of Matric certificate (Annexure P-1) wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 16.02.1992 whereas petitioner No.2 has also placed on record a copy of Matric certificate (Annexure P-2) depicting his date of birth as 14.06.1992. They have also moved a representation before the Sr.

Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar Rural (Annexure P-5) for protection of their life and liberty.

As per office report, service is effected on respondents No. 1 to 5 and 8.

Learned DAG state that on instructions from ASI Jagdeesh Rai no FIR has been lodged by the private respondent. None has appeared on behalf of private respondents.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-the Sr. Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar to look into the matter.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
