Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in this connection the petitioner has also moved complaint dated 31.05.2016 (Annexure P-1) and at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.3 to look into the matter and take appropriate action on his complaint within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.3-the SHO, Police Station Samana, District Patiala is directed to look into the matter and in case it is found that any action is required, to take whatever action he deems necessary as per law.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
