The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, in case FIR No.72 dated 22.03.2016, registered under Section 174-A of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station City-1, Abohar, Distt. Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that order dated 25.07.2016, stands complied with as the petitioner appeared before the trial Court. In support of his assertion, learned counsel has furnished a certified copy of order dated 29.07.2016, passed by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Abohar, which is taken on record as Mark 'A'.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, order dated 25.07.2016, is made absolute, subject to his

furnishing fresh bail bonds/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands allowed.
