The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 391 dated 20.09.2015 registered at Police Station Mataluda, District Panipat under Section 304-B IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that all the private witnesses have not supported the prosecution version and the petitioner is the mother-in-law and the husband is in custody. He further states that there was no dying declaration nor any suicide note was left.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the trial will take time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
