INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C.
for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.139 dated 26.02.2016, registered
at Police Station Hansi, District Hisar, under Sections 147, 149, 188,
436, 395, 427 and 450 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued in this case.

Mr. Vikramjit Singh, learned Addl. A. G. Haryana has put in
appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

From the record, I find that as per the allegations, on
21.02.2016, at about 4.30 p.m., petitioner-Bhim Singh @ Chirag as well
as co-accused Radhey Shyam alongwith a mob of around 1000-1200
people entered into the marriage palace of the complainant and destroyed

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it as well as water tank etc. and ultimately the marriage palace was set on fire.

The petitioner has been in custody since 07.03.2016. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
