INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.130 dated 02.07.2016, registered at Police Station Basti Bawa Khel, District Jalandhar, under Sections 353, 186, 506 and 427 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case.

Ms. Shivali, AAG, Punjab has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, the present petitioner in connivance with others abused the govt. officials and gave fist and leg blows on the govt. vehicle and broke the driver side back

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view mirror. The petitioner and others also tried to restrain the govt. officials and interrupted them from performing their official duty.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 25.07.2016 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is not required for custodial interrogation. Nothing is to be recovered from him.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 25.07.2016, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
