The instant petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.19 dated 14.03.2014, under Sections 363, 366-A, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Ramdass, District Amritsar.

Notices were in the said petition.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent-State submitted that a statement of prosecutrix had been recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C., in which the prosecutrix had exonerated the petitioners. Further, it was stated that a cancellation report had already been filed in the court on 12.03.2016.
