The petitioner seeks concession of pre-arrest bail in a case registered at the instance of Gurpal Singh alleging that the petitioner borrowed a sum of Rs.2.7 lakh from the complainant by mortgaging 6 tolas of gold. When the amount was demanded back, the petitioner required the complainant to sell the gold which was mortgaged and when the complainant approached the goldsmith, the gold was found to be impure. The petitioner is alleged to have not returned the money.

The petitioner, pursuant to the interim order has already joined the investigation. It appears to be a case of money transaction, petitioner having failed to return the amount.

In view of the said circumstances, the petition is allowed. Interim order dated 01.09.2015 is hereby made absolute subject to all the conditions under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
