This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.10 dated 20.01.2016 registered under Sections 419/365/384/201/120-B/34 IPC at Police Station City-II Mansa, District Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been in custody since 20.01.2016 and when the petitioner had come up for hearing on 08.08.2016 the matter was adjourned to enable the complainant to give his testimony on the date fixed which was 22.08.2016 but despite being served the complainant has not appeared. He further states that it is a

case of magisterial trial.

Learned Additional Advocate General on instructions from ASI Jasvir Singh has accepted these facts.

Keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
