JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, petitioners have sought pre-arrest bail, feeling apprehension of their arrest, in case bearing FIR No.100, dated 18.06.2016, under Sections 420, 406, 467, 468 and 471 IPC, Police Station Kamboj, District Amritsar (Rural).

2. At the time of issuance of notice of motion on 25.07.2016, following order was passed:-

*“Notice of motion to the respondents for
13.09.2016.*

Meanwhile, the petitioners are directed to join the investigation. In the event of arrest, petitioners shall be released on pre-arrest bail at the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. as well as to deposit a

sum of Rs.1 lac with the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate within a period of 7 days from today.”

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Balraj Singh, Police Station Kamboj, District Amritsar (Rural) has fairly conceded that in compliance of order dated 25.07.2016, petitioners have already joined the investigation. They are no more required for further investigation/interrogation.

4. Taking into consideration the aforesaid aspects of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits, the petition is allowed and order dated 25.07.2016 is made absolute and shall enure during the pendency of trial but subject to the conditions provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
