Through the instant petition, the petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.51 dated 20.05.2016, registered under Sections 376/506 IPC, Police Station Sujanpur, Distt. Pathankot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the interim order date 09.08.2016, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and has cooperated.

Learned State counsel states that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Looking to all these circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 09.08.2016 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure with a rider that the petitioner would not contact the victim and would not tamper with evidence.
