Prayer in the present petition is for quashing of FIR No.60 dated 28.2.2012 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 323, 452, 506, 447, 511, 380, 34, 457 IPC, registered at Police Station Tripri Town alongwith all consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Vide order dated 8.1.2016, this Court has directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to forward a report about the genuineness of the

compromise to this Court.

In compliance of the order dated 8.1.2016, the parties have appeared before the learned Magistrate on 10.3.2016 for getting their statements recorded.

However, respondent No.2-complainant Surjit Singh has recorded his statement on 10.3.2016 before the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Patiala, that no compromise has been entered between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners at this stage wishes to withdraw the present petition, however, with liberty to file fresh one either on merits or on the basis of compromise, if arrived at between the parties.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
