By virtue of the instant petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C., petitioner has sought quashing of FIR No.223 dated 03.05.2015, under Sections 323, 452, 356, 436, 506, 201 read with Section 34 IPC and Section 3 of SC/ST Act, registered at Police Station Sadar, Bahadurgarh (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising out therefrom qua the petitioner.
