Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.121 dated 30.4.2016 under Sections 408, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Industrial Area, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 5.9.2016 of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Parvinder Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and submits that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required at this stage, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 5.9.2016 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
