Petitioner is aggrieved by the order passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Jind, issuing non-bailable warrants against the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner has contended that the petitioner has a reasonable ground for non-appearance on a particular day as he had gone to Delhi to see his relative who is seriously ill.

Petitioner challenges the order dated 14.7.2016.

I have considered the contentions of learned counsel for the petitioner and I am of the opinion that the petitioner has got number of remedies available to him to protect his liberty i.e. to file (i) an application under Section 70 (2) Cr.P.C. for cancellation of the warrants explaining the circumstances of non-appearance and offering to appear (ii) a revision petition before the Sessions Court against the impugned order (iii) an application under Section 438 Cr.P.C., by approaching the Sessions Court and (iv) a revision petition against the cancellation of bail bonds.

Counsel for the petitioner in view of above circumstances seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail other remedies available to the petitioner.

Disposed of as withdrawn without prejudice to the rights of the petitioner to avail other remedies available to him.
