The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR
No.298, dated 6.8.2011, registered under Sections 307, 326, 323, 324,
427, 34 of the IPC, at Police Station City Sangrur.

In the order dated 12.7.2016, passed by the trial Court
declining bail to the petitioner, it has been observed as under :-

“8. Addl. PP for the State Shri Hussan Bansal with
consultation of Investigation officer stated that
evidence of the prosecution will be concluded within
one and half month.

9. Accordingly no ground for bail is made out. However, it is made clear that in case prosecution fails to conclude its evidence within one and half months from today then applicant-accused will be entitled to move fresh bail application for bail on this ground. Bail papers be attached with the main challan.”

In this view of the matter, I find no ground to interfere.

Consequently, this petition is dismissed.
