This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.15 dated 21.02.2014, registered at Police Station Sadar Batala, District Gurdaspur, under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Notice of motion has been issued in this case.

Ms. Shivali, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner absented himself from the court proceedings on 17.12.2015. The petitioner has already been declared proclaimed offender on 26.07.2016, as stated by

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learned State counsel after seeking instructions from Head Constable Balraj Singh. No reasonable ground has been given by the petitioner for his absence from the court proceedings.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled for the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.
