The present petition has been filed under Section 439(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.') seeking cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to accused-respondent Nos.2 and 3, by learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Sangrur, vide impugned order dated 07.06.2016 (Annexure P-3), in case FIR No.181 dated 01.06.2016, registered under Section 306 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station City Sangrur.

Learned counsel contends that accused-respondent Nos.2 and 3 have been specifically named in the suicide note left by his father, since deceased. Therefore, keeping in view the gravity of the offence, the accused ought not have been granted the concession of anticipatory bail. However, he has candidly accepted that the accused-respondent Nos.2 and 3 are neither intimidating the complainant, nor interfering in the trial, in any

manner.

In view of the above, no case for cancellation of bail is made out.

Dismissed.
