The petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.158 dated 15.10.2015 registered under Sections 302, 148 & 149 IPC at Police Station Gate Hakima, District Amritsar.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioners were made accused at later point of time by virtue of Section 319 Cr.P.C. Consequently the FIR No.158 was registered against them.

This Court found prima facie case and passed interim order dated 02.08.2016 granting ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

The petitioners were found innocent earlier during investigation.

In compliance of order dated 02.08.2016 the petitioners have furnished bail bonds by appearing before the trial Judge. In that view of the matter interim order dated 02.08.2016 is made absolute.

Disposed of accordingly.
