Prayer made in the instant petition is for issuance of a direction to respondents No. 1 to 3 to conduct proper investigation in case FIR No.62, dated 12.04.2014 under Sections 452, 447, 427, 341, 323, 148 and 149, registered at Police Station, Ajnala, District-Amritsar Rural (Annexure P-1), as despite registration of the abovesaid case, the police has failed to file the challan.

Learned counsel for the State has filed reply by way of affidavit of Tilak Raj, PPS, Dy. Supdt. of Police, Sub Division Ajnala, Distt. Amritsar (Rural) on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4, which is taken on record.

The said reply reveals that investigation in the present case is complete and after completion of the investigation, the police

has presented the challan in the Court of Illaqa Magistrate on 28.10.2015, wherein charges have also been framed on 07.01.2016 and now the case is fixed for prosecution evidence on 10.03.2016.

In view of aforesaid developments, the prayer of the petitioner has become infructuous and, therefore, the present petition is disposed of accordingly.
