Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No. 140 dated 23.09.2009 under Sections 452/326/323/324/34 IPC registered at Police Station Majitha, District Amritsar (Rural) at the instance of respondent No. 2 - Charanjit Singh alleging that on 19.09.2009, the petitioners armed with weapons had assaulted the complainant by trespassing in his house. Quashing has been sought on the basis of compromise.

After recording the statements of the parties, a report has been sent by the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Amritsar, to the effect that the matter has been compromised. Following the report of the said Court, and in view of the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **“Kulwinder Singh vs. State of Punjab, 2007 (3) Recent Criminal Reports (P&H), 1052”**, I am of the opinion that on account of the matter having been amicably resolved between the parties, neither any useful

purpose will be served nor any fruitful result would be achieved by keeping the proceedings pending, as the matter has been compromised.

The petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the consequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise.
