Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Amarpal Singh @ Kala in case FIR No.179 dated 02.10.2014 for offences punishable under Sections 22/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered with Police Station Kotwali, Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

There was a recovery of 225 grams of intoxicating powder.

Since there was no report of the Chemical Examiner, petitioner was ordered to be released on interim bail on 12.02.2015. Now the Chemical Examiner report has come in December, 2015 indicating that the seized substance contains Diphenoxylate Hydrochloride of a percentage which renders the contraband to be of commercial nature.

After arguing for sometime, learned Counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
